



## "Why is water wet?"



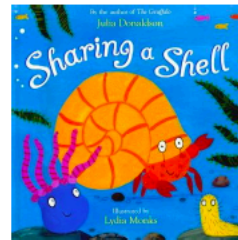
### Creative

- Your child could make fish shaped cookies and decorate with coloured icing.
- They could also create their own pond in a water tray using small world fish.
- Your child could try making a handprint fish.



### Talk/Read

- Please read the story 'Sharing a Shell' by Julia Donaldson. It is available on youtube <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=VpJumAZx1t8>
- You could talk to your child about sharing and being kind to our friends/siblings.
- Talk about animals that live under the sea - can your child think of any that weren't in the story?



### Maths

- If you have a trip to the beach, you could collect shells and encourage your child to count them. They could talk about the similarities and differences between the shells too!
- Encourage your child to count out sets of stones/shells/twigs. Which set has the most/least? Can your child write the corresponding number?



### Mark making/Writing

- Draw a picture of a fish. Can your child talk about the different parts of a fish e.g. scales, fins, tail.
- Encourage your child to listen for the sounds in the words e.g. f-i-n ... can they write the sounds to label their picture?



Please continue to encourage your child to practice writing their name, read a story and sing nursery rhymes daily.
