

Why do spiders eat flies?



Maths Fluency Ladder	
6	Subtracting 1 (within 10) (EYFS)

Can you continue with fluency games this week? Can you chalk numbers to 20 onto the ground. Can one person select a number and the fastest person in the family to splat it is the winner! How quickly can you add one more or one less to the number you splat? 😊



Maths

This week print different spider leg doubles by using pipe cleaners and toilet roll tubes. Splat the spider legs and write the numbers as a double or an addition sum. $2 + 2 = 4$ or double 2 is 4. $4 + 4 = 8$ or double 4 is 8. See how quickly your child can learn and repeat their doubles to 10. Can they begin to learn their doubles beyond 10? For example, double 6 or double 8? Use some double songs on YouTube to help with fluency.



Reading

This week can you read Aaaarrgghh Spider together. You will also find this online. Use this story to learn about the life cycle of a Spider. Make links to last weeks like cycles and the life cycle of our chicks in school. Allow the children time to explain what they know about life cycles and share your thoughts together. Reflect on what your household pets are like and if they can too look after themselves.
