### Creative

- Try making a telescope to look for pirates!
- Your child could make a pirate out of a cardboard tube.



### Talk/Sing

- Learn a pirate song! Sing it to the tune 'if you're happy and you know it'. I will post the words on another page 😊.
- Your child could hide some 'treasure'. They could then give you clues to where they have hidden it. Encourage your child to us positional language e.g. it is next to... it is under....on top/behind/in front etc.

### Maths

- Try counting pieces of 'treasure' in different groups (up to 5).
- Can your child write the number?



### Mark making/Writing

- Encourage your child to draw a picture of a parrot or a pirate ship. Can they hear the initial sound 'p' in parrot? If you suggested that they draw a sh - i - p can they blend the sounds to hear the word ship?
- Your child could use sticks to make an 'x' marks the spot in the mud outside.



Please continue to encourage your child to practise writing their name, read a story and sing nursery rhymes daily.
